Mentor teachers played a crucial role in guiding the students, helping them translate their ideas into tangible outcomes.

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PREFACE

In the realm of education, inclusivity has emerged as an indispensable element of contemporary learning. Providing all students, irrespective of their abilities, with equitable access to learning resources represents a significant advancement toward a more inclusive society. Quizabled is an innovative initiative making considerable progress in this direction.

As Quizabled commences its tenth year, it has distinguished itself with a unique knowledge development platform specifically designed for children and youth with disabilities, thereby transforming the landscape of quizzing events in India. Since 2016, this Seva-in-Action initiative, supported by the LTIMindtree Foundation (formerly LTI), has expanded to encompass over 700 schools and engage more than 11,300 participants nationwide. Quizabled has been registered as an independent entity known as Quizabled Foundation, thereby reaffirming its commitment to knowledge development, the empowerment of persons with disabilities, and the promotion of inclusivity.

This year, Quizabled extended its reach to 14 states, encompassing Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu in the South; Maharashtra and Gujarat in the West; Odisha in the East; Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, and Madhya Pradesh in the North and Central regions; and Assam and Meghalaya in the Northeast. A particularly noteworthy milestone in the journey of Quizabled was its expansion into the Northeast through Assam and Meghalaya.

Furthermore, this year, Quizabled was featured on DD Chandana, showcasing quizzes designed for students with visual and hearing impairments on the International Day of Persons with Disabilities.

The launch of the Innovative Learning Activities and Projects (ILAP) initiative marks another significant development, which is specifically designed to cultivate 21st-century skills, such as critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication, among students with special needs. ILAP incorporates STEAM education to foster creativity and innovation, thereby shifting the focus from knowledge acquisition to practical application.

The contributions of NGO partners, principals, teachers, and parents have been instrumental in the success of Quizabled. As we look to the future, Quizabled plans to expand its reach to underserved states in Northeast and Central India, creating a platform that supports knowledge development. Quizabled will also focus on innovative learning activities that foster creativity and facilitate new teaching approaches for children with disabilities.

This includes capacity building for teachers to showcase innovative teaching and learning methods, and to promote the exchange of information and knowledge among teachers and schools in different states. The goal is to develop an enriching learning environment that supports the learning and development of children with disabilities.

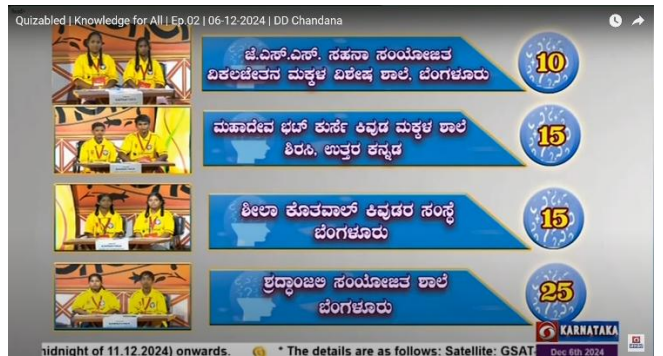


Quiz Broadcast on DD Chandana for Children & Youth with Visual & Hearing Impairment During International Day of Persons with Disabilities

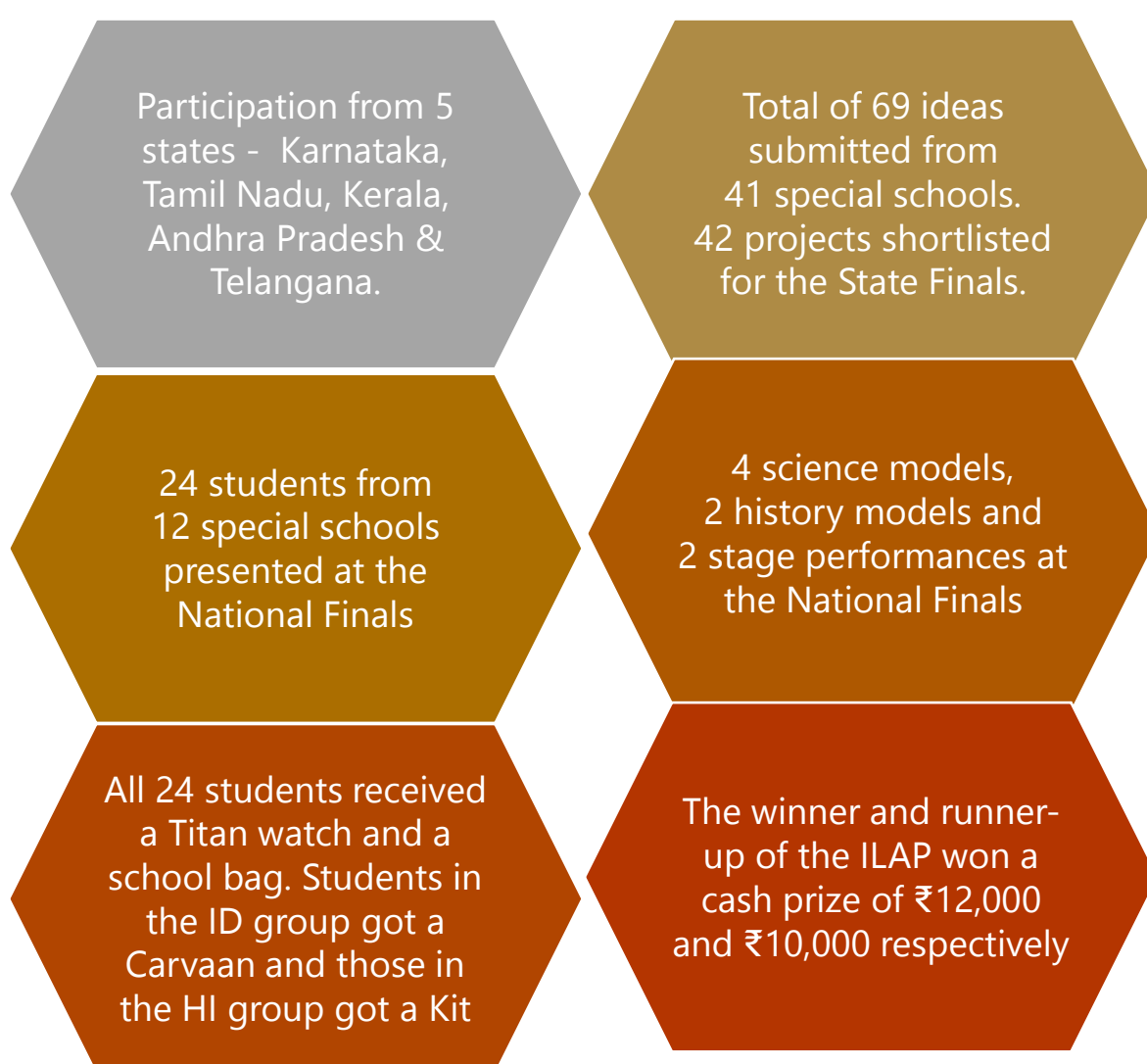

INNOVATIVE LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS (ILAP)

The Innovative Learning Activities and Projects (ILAP) is a contest exclusive for children and youth with disabilities (Intellectual Disability and Hearing Impairment) under the Quizabled Foundation organized by Seva-in-Action. The goal of ILAP is to help students from middle and secondary schools, studying in grades 6 – 12 to showcase innovative learning activities and projects.

In the year 2024-25, ILAP was piloted across five states – Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. Out of a total of 69 ideas submitted from 41 special schools, 44 ideas were approved from 33 schools. 24 students from 12 schools presented 12 projects at the National Finals held in Bangalore on January 11, 2025. This initiative is the first step for Quizabled to move from focusing on knowledge and understanding to fostering application and innovation.

Excursion in Bangalore

As part of the educational excursion organized by **Seva-in-Action**, the **Quizabled & ILAP National Finalists**, along with their mentor teachers and parents, visited several iconic educational and recreational spots in Bangalore. The group explored the **Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum**, experienced the wonders of space at the **Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium**, and enjoyed inclusive play at the **accessible park created by LTIMindtree at Cubbon park**.



The children, parents & teachers expressed, they thoroughly enjoyed the excursion, which provided not only entertainment but also valuable learning experiences across science, technology, and accessibility.





Stating that children with disability should not be confined inside the four walls of the school, Banerjee said they are trying to provide opportunities to make learning much more interesting and participatory for them. "It is not only book learning but it is also (about) what is happening around them... The other most important thing is to break the myths among parents and teachers; most of us have low expectations from these children, thinking that they will not be able to participate in such knowledge platforms. But we are trying to break these stereotypes," she added.

Started in 2016 with 100 children in Bangalore, Quizzabled has travelled to different parts of the country and in Meghalaya, it is the first of its kind and second in the Northeast region, after Assam.

When asked about the response of the parents and teachers, Ruma Banerjee said the response the organization has received so far has been tremendous with the number of participants increasing every year.

"The way the format is developed is very simple. We give them multiple-option questions related to something interesting like music, sports, and local things which are happening around. It is not that they have to memorize something but it is making them understand, reason out and giving them choices," she added.

Challenging Societal Stereotypes with 'Quizzabled'

It's not all about your IQ, it is more about participation – a chance to be part of something meaningful and interesting.

With this thought in mind Seva-in-Action & powered by LTIMindtree Foundation, in collaboration with the Meghalaya Parents' Association for Disabled (MePAD), organised the 10th edition of Quizzabled, a unique platform for children and youth with disabilities to showcase their abilities in the context of their learning, at Meghalaya Bharat Scouts & Guides Auditorium in Shillong on March 18.

Excitement filled the auditorium as students eagerly waited for their turn to answer; parents were filled with pride and joy to see their children go up on stage, displaying a sense of confidence and courage and organisers wore a contented look as the event concluded on a successful note. The competition was more than just a contest, it's about showcasing their talents and abilities, promoting inclusion and challenging societal stereotypes.

"We are a voluntary organization for the past 40 years especially in the field of disability – primarily in the field of inclusive education & development programs. The objective is to have any such platform where children can showcase their abilities in the context of their learning, in the context of their knowledge, I'm trying to come up with an innovative pedagogy way of teaching-learning for these children," Vice Chairperson of Seva in Action Ruma Banerjee.



Applauding the initiative of Seva-in-Action, MePAD president Nabarun Sen Gupta informed that students from around 86 participants from six to seven districts of Meghalaya participated in the event. "This is the first time the event is being held in Meghalaya and we plan to make it into an annual event," he said.

Referring to the stigma surrounding the issue, Sen Gupta said that parents are often apprehensive about sending their children to such gatherings. But today's event was an eye-opener for many parents and teachers, he added.

Meanwhile, Quizmaster Himadri Banerjee, who has been on the job for 10 years now, said patience is the key to successfully host such events. "I have been doing this for 10 years across India and I have learned over the years how to frame questions for children with disability; it requires a lot of patience and more straightforward and familiar questions. The idea is not to make the questions challenging for them but accessible," he remarked.

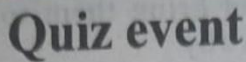

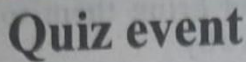
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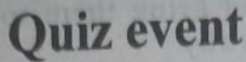
