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

Launched in 2016 by **Seva-in-Action (SiA)** and sponsored by LTIMindtree Foundation under their CSR initiative, Quizabled aims to raise awareness, challenge stereotypes, and highlight the potential of children and youth with disabilities.

What?

- PAN India Innovative quiz competition
- Reached 12,000+ students in 1300 schools across 15 states in India with 14+ outreach partners

Why?

- Build knowledge on various topics such as history, current affairs, etc.
- Instills team-spirit, self-esteem and confidence
- Teachers, parents and students discover untapped capabilities

Who?

- Students with Intellectual Disabilities (Juniors): 13 –18 yrs
- Students with Intellectual Disabilities (Seniors): 18 –25 yrs
- Students with Cerebral Palsy: 13 –21 yrs
- Students with Hearing Impairment: 7th std – 10th std

* Each team must consist of 2 students with the same type of disability and from the same school or organization.

Quiz Topics

1. General knowledge with National & international current affairs
2. History & culture
3. Science & technology
4. Sports & games
5. Local traditions & festivals
6. Cartoon, monuments & famous personalities
7. Guess the voices (birds, animals, famous personalities, instruments etc)
