# REPORT OF QUIZABLED - KNOWLEDGE DEVELOPMENT PLATFORM 2023 – 24

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## SUMMARY

### INTRODUCTION

Quizabled has been a distinctive event in the space of disabilities for the past nine years for children & youth with disabilities. It is designed to include five different categories of disabilities namely: Intellectual Disability (ID), Cerebral Palsy (CP), Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Visual Impairment (VI) and Hearing Impairment (HI).

The 9th year of Quizabled has become a pan India program and reached out to 10 States with 2968 children & youth with disabilities from 311 schools. It was extended to **Kolkata, West Bengal & Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, this year we continued with Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Delhi, Bhubaneswar, Odisha, Kerala, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.** Quizabled has progressed with the theme of “**Celebrating Diversity & Empowering the lives**”. It has provided with a platform to nurture the abilities and celebrating diversity to develop an inclusive society.

### Impact of Quizabled


The impact of Quizabled has been tremendous with 2968 children participating from 10 states. It has generated an awareness regarding the abilities of differently abled children and the need for creating an accessible, engaging, and sustainable knowledge development platform. This event has created opportunities to empower the lives of the differently abled so as to ensure that they can experience quality access to knowledge development, socialization and a step towards feeling inclusive. It has broken myths about children with intellectual disabilities. Their participation was highest compared to other disabilities.

- **Empowerment and Celebration:** The National Finals organized first time for children and youths with visual and hearing impairments marked a significant milestone in promoting inclusion and celebrating diversity countrywide.
- **Quizabled Continues to scale up:** The Pan India quiz competition for differently abled students, achieving significant growth and impact. With nearly 2968 participants from 10 different states across India, Quizabled has reached out to unreached districts in Karnataka and Tamilnadu. Thus providing opportunities to rural areas for children and youths with disabilities to showcase their talents and intellectual capabilities.

- **Diversity in Participation:** Participants from various States such as Tamil Nadu, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, West Bengal, and Karnataka showcased their quizzing skills, highlighting the diversity of talents and abilities present among differently abled students across the country.
- **Innovative Quizzing Practices:** The year 2023-24 witnessed innovative inclusive practices within Quizabled, such as devising novel methods for participation to accommodate different types of disabilities. For example, a child with cerebral palsy in Tamil Nadu utilized a unique method of indicating quiz options using a stick attached to their head, demonstrating the creativity and adaptability of participants.
- **Networking and Support:** Quizabled continued to receive support from NGO partners, Seva-in-Action and LTIMindtree under its CSR initiative, showcasing the networking and power of collaboration in driving social impact and promoting inclusivity.

In conclusion, organizing quizzes for differently abled children can be a powerful way to promote social, economic, and political inclusion and reduce inequalities, which are the core objectives of SDG 10 (Reducing Inequalities).

## QUIZZING FORMAT

### Registration

Online registration was done for intellectual disabilities (GP A) Cerebral palsy and Autism (GP B) Visual impaired (GP C) Hearing impaired (GP D). In the online registration form, the team of two children/youth with disabilities were asked to select their respective State to complete their registration. The selection will finalize their registration and facilitate the division of participants into groups based on their disability category which was ABC&D.

- **Group A** – Children & youth with Intellectual Disability
- **Group B** – Children & youth with Cerebral Palsy & Autism Spectrum Disorder
- **Group C** – Children & youth with Visual Impairment
- **Group D** – Children & youth with Hearing Impairment

### Prelims & Semi finals

- Preliminary round took place will take place in a web portal format, while the finals will be held physically.
- Following the preliminary rounds, we conducted semi-final rounds in 5 States leading up to the State Finals and National Final. This format allows for a combination of online accessibility and in-person engagement, ensuring broader participation while maintaining the excitement of live competition during the final stages.

### Question format for PRELIMS and Semi-finals by following rules:

- 15 – 20 Questions
- Time – 30 – 40 mins
- No Negative marking
- They have tick the right answer or write the correct option on the right.
- Use only Pen (Any ink except red colour is allowed)


### Quiz Finals

- The top 6 qualified teams from each category of Group was selected for state finals.
- The top scorer from this final was declared as winner and the second top scorer was declared as runner-up.

### National Finals

- The winners from the Group C & D (children & youth with VI & HI) qualified for the National finals, this year we have piloted for the first time national finals.
- The top scorer was crowned the National Champion.

All the 10 States had the Quiz including PRELIMS, Semi-finals, State finals and National final were held on a digital platform and physical hosted by the Quizmasters from 4 Edge Quizzing solutions and Catalyst Quiz corp.




## ACCESSIBLE WEB PORTAL

Quizabled is a web portal designed to provide a digital platform of resources for quiz participants throughout the year. The preliminary rounds were held in Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, and Andhra Pradesh, with a total of 1490 students from rural and urban districts. Among them, 872 children with intellectual disabilities, 208 Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Cerebral Palsy (CP) and 410 Hearing Impairment took part from Groups A, B, and D. Additionally, a semi-final was conducted specifically for 60 children and youth with intellectual disabilities (Group A) in Karnataka to select the finalists.

### Feedback from the NGO partners

Seva-in-Action conducted feedback meeting with NGO partners on January 23, 2024, to address challenges and solutions for improvement collaboratively. During the meeting, various challenges have been identified and discussed along with corresponding suggestions for improvement. Some of the challenges and suggestions to improve could include:

- District wise participations and competitions are required to cover rural area for getting more participants.
- Dividing the participants into Junior and Senior groups within the Intellectual Disability (ID) category because more no of children with age group of above 21 are present in the special schools.
- District wise competition to be required to provide more opportunities to rural and Semi-urban rather than only concentrating on one districts.
- Junior and senior group may be determined for expanding the age limit in Quizabled
- Conducting Quiz for graduates especially Group C & D youth with disabilities would help them to appear for the competitive exams.
- Intended to be Conduct Quizabled before September each year is a prudent decision, considering various factors such as the timing of board exams and weather conditions in Tamil Nadu
- Conducting Prelims through online mode is more convenient using less human resource -volunteers in compare to offline Quiz. West Bengal may be divided into 2 geographical areas i.e., South Bengal- Kolkata and North Bengal - Siliguri



## Detailed Report

### THE OVERVIEW OF THE QUIZABLED EVENTS HELD FOR THE YEAR 2023-24 IN 10 STATES OF INDIA BY SEVA-IN-ACTION WITH ITS NGO PARTNERS AND POWERED BY LTIMINDTREE

#### ACCESSIBLE WEB PORTAL

Quizabled was organised in a hybrid mode, the registration was done through web portal for students to participate in the preliminary rounds. Totally 2968 children & youth with disabilities from Group A, B, and D had registered. Additionally, we conducted semi-finals specifically for children and youth with intellectual disabilities in Karnataka. The Quizabled web portal was developed for providing resources and opportunities for children and youth with disabilities to prepare for quizzes in a structured and supportive manner. Publicity Materials: Teasers videos, Flyers and brochures were developed for creating awareness among schools in various states.

#### IMPLEMENTATION OF THE QUIZABLED EVENT

##### On boarding and registration process:

- Identifying local NGO Partners in Kolkata Lucknow and Bhubaneswar the new states
- Training to NGO partners about Quizabled and plans
- NGO partners to identify more number of schools to be contacted for reaching out rural areas.

- Orientation to teachers and caregivers of respective schools about Quizabled formats and preparations.



## REGISTRATION


The NGO partners from all the 10 States (Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Delhi, Odisha, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal) identified and mapped the special and mainstream Schools from other Districts. A total number of 2968 Children & youth with Intellectual Disability, Cerebral Palsy, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Visual impairment and Hearing impairment from 311 schools registered through the Quizabled web portal.



## PRELIMINARY ROUND

The preliminary round was conducted through web portal for Children from Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Andhra Pradesh for Group A (Children & Youth with Intellectual Disability), Group B (Children & Youth with ASD & CP) and Group D (Children & Youth with Hearing Impairment) with the support of volunteers and their teachers to log in with their respective IDs & Passwords to attend the quiz, a total of 20 questions designed with a timer of 15 minutes. Totally 1492 children & youth with disabilities participated in the PRELIMS. In other States like Delhi, Kerala, Odisha, Telangana, Lucknow, UP and Kolkata, WB conducted physically with the support of volunteers from LTIMindtree and trainees from different collages & institutes.





## SEMI-FINALS

This year the semi-final was conducted for Group A in Karnataka through web portal for 30 teams to select finalists. In Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra, we conducted physically on the final day with the support of LTIMindtree volunteers.



## INAUGURATION DURING THE STATE FINALS

In all the 10 States, MCs welcomed the audience, safety measures were announced, the National Anthem was played and the Quizabled edition curtain raiser was opened. The Guests were invited to light the lamp and the programme was launched by the Chief Guest and gave an introduction to the guests and guests were invited to address the occasion with their brief speeches.



The quiz masters Mr. Himadri Banerjee from 4 Edge Quizzing solutions & Mr. Surya Narayanan from Catalyst Quiz Corp were invited to brief the participants about the prelims and then the finals.

# Quizabled National Finals at Bengaluru

In the 9<sup>th</sup> year Quizabled, a major milestone was achieved for conducting National finals for the first time for 10 States across the country covering East Kolkata and Bhubaneswar, West Mumbai, North Lucknow and Delhi and South Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Kerala. Quizabled has not only created an exciting and accessible environment for quizzing but also fostered inclusion and knowledge development among participants.

The collaboration with professional quizmasters from 4Edge Quizzing Solutions to conduct the National finals for children and youth with hearing and visual impairments represents a significant step forward in promoting inclusivity and celebrating diversity. This National finale, bringing together participants from diverse linguistic and geographical backgrounds, will undoubtedly be a testament to the richness of India. Through initiatives like these, Quizabled is not only providing a platform for individuals with disabilities to showcase their talents but also breaking barriers and promoting understanding and acceptance within society. It's events like the National finals that highlight the potential and abilities of every individual, regardless of their disabilities, and foster a sense of belonging and empowerment.

## Inauguration

The MC set the stage and gave the Safety and General instructions to the students/ Escorts/ teachers/ audience as a precaution and to guide them for any support. The inauguration began with silent **National Anthem and Deepa Nruthya dance** by the Students of Shri Ramana Maharishi Academy for the Blind. Then MC gave brief intro about Quizabled, SiA, LTIMindtree & 4Edge Quizzing Solutions followed by the video on the 9<sup>th</sup> Edition Quizabled journey of 10 States.



The valedictory of the event was graced by the chief guest, Shri A. Narayanaswamy, Minister of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. Accompanying him were the guest of honours: Smt. Yamuna, Assistant Commissioner at the Office of the State Commissioner for Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, Government of Karnataka; Dr. Na. Someswara, Writer & Television Presenter at Doordarshan; and Mr. Ramesh Revuru, Global Head - Low Code at LTI Mindtree. Their presence added prestige and significance to the valedictory of the event.

## FINAL ROUND

The final round of the quiz was conducted in a dynamic format by incorporating both verbal and nonverbal components. Mr. Himadri, the Quiz Master from 4 Edge Quizzing Solutions, played a vital role in conducting the final round. The questions were presented to the participants verbally by Mr. Himadri and simultaneously, they were projected onto an LED wall with accompanying audio-visual stimuli.





The questions in the final round encompassed various formats, including Multiple-choice questions, Direct questions & Audio-visual rounds. This diverse range of question types likely provided an engaging and challenging experience for the participants, testing their knowledge and skills across different domains. Questions were asked in the local language to make the participants comfortable which was done by MC and Quiz Master where ever necessary.

To ensure wider accessibility and engagement, the National finals was live-streamed on YouTube, allowing audiences to watch the quiz in real-time from anywhere. The YouTube live streaming link was shared with all stakeholders, enabling them to tune in and support the participants during the event.

The winners from Group C & D (children & youth with visual & hearing impairment) from 10 states participated in the National finals. The winner rewarded with cash prize of Rs. 30000/- & Runner up teams were rewarded with cash prize of Rs. 15000/- along with achievement certificate & trophy. Apart from Winner & Runner up teams the other finalists received the Goodies (Bag pack & Pencil Box) and certificates as Consolidation prizes.

## Challenges

- **Physical Accessibility** - Ensuring the venue is physically accessible in all the States to children with use wheelchairs or mobility aids such as ramps, elevators, wide doorways, accessible restrooms, and designated parking spaces.
- **Sensory Accessibility:** This year, we had children with sensory disabilities with deaf blindness. Ensuring the appropriate communication by the teachers & volunteers.
- **Technical Accessibility:** Ensuring internet accessible in the districts to participate in the online Prelims and navigation to the website and other accessibility features like login issues.
- Sensitivity of volunteers towards disability and ensuring the involvement of volunteers to provide necessary assistance during Prelims, stage finals etc. when it is needed.

## Way Forward

- Quizabled distinctive approach in the field of disabilities has generated enthusiasm and interest among children with disabilities and teachers working for them therefore there is a need to reach out at more number of children. The most appropriate means will be through online approach which enable more number of students to participate.
- Developing the portal for doing the online prelims for 90% of the target group. Except in cases where network and connectivity issues are existing.
- Quizabled needs to be streamlined in order to reach out to larger students with in a given time period. Therefore, it is suggested to have four seminal finals in four regions followed by National finals.
- To plan Quizabled activities to reach out to maximum number of districts in the 10 states
- To register Quizabled under section 8 company for sustainability and for upscaling in other states thus providing with a unique and innovative knowledge platform in the disability space.



## ONE DAY TRIP TO MYSURU

Seva-in-Action has organized a one-day trip to Mysuru for all the National finalists in Quizabled, it is a memorable experience for them. We organised bus for all the participants and the teachers pick up at the designated point for departure. The group visited the Chamundi Hill to visit the Chamundeshwari Temple and admire the panoramic views of Mysuru from the hilltop. Then they head to iconic Mysuru Palace, provides insights into its history, architecture, and cultural significance. They all enjoyed a delicious breakfast & lunch at a local restaurant, featuring authentic South Indian cuisine. This one-day trip provided Quizabled national finalists with a blend of cultural immersion, sightseeing, and solidarity, fostering a memorable and enriching experience.



## CASE STUDY



**Krishna Seth**, is studying in the 12th standard at St. Rock's High School & Jr College, Borivali (west). 

## PREPARATIONS FOR ORGANIZING THE QUIZABLED IN COLLABORATION WITH NGO PARTNERS POWERED BY LTIMINDTREE

### Meetings & Planning with NGO Partners

Seva-in-Action with LTIMindtree and NGO Partners along with Quizzing partners met frequently online to plan and work with a pre-determined direction. We planned based on the feedbacks from the school & NGO partners. After discussion with SiA team, LTIMindtree, NGO partners & the Quiz Masters decided once again to launch “Quizabled” through a hybrid mode in four states where the registered number was high.

### Training to Teachers and Caregivers

Virtual training sessions were conducted through Zoom to orient teachers & caregivers about Quizabled. We gave inputs on the Quizabled event and about navigating through the web-portal for registrations, Mock Quiz Features and Quizzing pattern. The training sessions were conducted across 2 months which covered existing districts & new districts. In each session 30 - 35 teachers & caregivers participated.

**The following resources were provided to aid in preparation:**

- Mock test was created in the web portal with innovative questions developed by quizmasters for all the groups.
- Shared the sample question papers to schools

### Orientation to volunteers

Virtual orientation sessions were conducted through Zoom before the events in each state on the process of Quizabled and volunteer’s requirement in all the counters like

1. Registration
2. Conducting prelims
3. Correction of question papers
4. Setting up the stage
5. Writing certificates

6. Escorting the participants to the stage and standing behind to help them to understand the questions
7. Assisting in supplying of the food to the wheel chair users.
