INTRODUCTION

Quizabled is a unique annual event organized by Seva-in-Action (SiA) in collaboration and powered by Larsen and Toubro Infotech Ltd (LTI), Bengaluru. It is a special quiz competition conducted exclusively for children with disabilities for special and regular schools. Quizabled was curated and developed in partnership with 4 edge quizzing solution. It is the first of its kind quiz in the country where differently abled participants (cross disability) were given an opportunity to showcase their knowledge and intellectual potentials.

To celebrate International Day of People with disabilities, Seva-in-Action (SiA) organized the event the Quizabled from past 4 years, powered by LTI. The **5th year of Quizabled** is reached to 5 other Districts & Bengaluru of Karnataka besides Chennai in collaboration with SPATN, Tamilnadu and Mumbai in collaboration with Sujaya Foundation, Maharashtra.

This is the **5th Edition** of the Quizabled - **In Bengaluru**, the Prelims were conducted on 13th Nov 2019 in 7 Nodal centres across Bengaluru. **Totally 350 children from 34 schools** were participated. **In 5 Districts** (Kalaburagi, Dharwada, Davanagere, Gadag and Mysuru of Karnataka **228 Children with HI & VI** participated in the Prelims and it was conducted **on 6th Nov 2019** at Govt schools for the Blind and Sri. B.D. Tatti Memorial School for the Deaf. The **Final event** is conducted on **23rd November 2019** at BMS College of Engineering, Indoor stadium, Bengaluru conducted by the Quiz master Ms. Meghavi Manjunath from **Quiriosity Knowledge solutions**.

In Mumbai, the prelims and finals were conducted **on 7th Dec 2019** at St. Andrews College Hall, Bandra conducted by the Quiz masters **Mr. Amit and Ms. Meghavi** from Quiriosity Knowledge Solutions. **Totally 148 children from 60 schools** were participated.

In Chennai, the prelims and finals were conducted on **25th Jan 2020** at the **SPASTN Auditorium** conducted by the Quiz masters **Mr. Surya Narayan and Mr. Sai** from **Catalyst Quiz Corp.** **Totally 178 children** from --- schools were participated. The Children are from Chennai, Thiruvallur, Thiruvannamalai, Chengalpet, Kanchipuram and Cuddalore.

The winners & Runner up teams from 4 groups got cash prizes with achievement certificate & trophy. There was a consolation prize for other teams that qualified for the final rounds. A total of 900 children with Disabilities and 1000 people comprise LTI, SF & SPASTN volunteers, special schools teachers, parents/caretakers participated in the event and made the special quiz competition, **QUIZABLED 2019'** grand success.



PRELIMINARY ROUND


IN 5 DISTRICTS

The PRELIMS were conducted on 6th Nov 2019 in 5 other Districts of Karnataka i.e. **Mysuru, Davanagere, Dharwada, Gadaga, and Kalaburagi**. Totally, 228 children participated from 22 special schools for Blind and Deaf Children.

The children participated in the following Nodal Centres.

In the prelims the printed question paper was issued to the teams of Blind and Deaf children with the assistance of scribes to mark & write the answers. 4. **Group D:** Hearing Impaired.






PRELIMINARY ROUND & FINALS

The Preliminary and finals were conducted on the same day. **The students were categorised in the following three groups:**

1. **Group A** – Children with Intellectual Disability & Cerebral palsy / Autism - As there were less students under Cerebral Palsy/Autism we combined the first two kinds of disabilities
2. **Group B** – Children with Visual Impairment
3. **Group C** – Children with Hearing Impairment

A total of 36 students from Group A, B & C were qualified for the final rounds. The winners from 3 groups were rewarded with cash prize of Rs. 8000/- & Runner up teams were rewarded with cash prize of Rs. 5000/- along with achievement certificate & medals. Apart from Winner & Runner up teams the participants who were qualified for the final rounds also received the Goodie bags and certificates as Consolation prizes.






School visit in Bengaluru
