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OVERVIEW

This year Quizabled is reached to 4 other Districts & Bengaluru of Karnataka besides Chennai in collaboration with SPASTN, Tamilnadu and Mumbai in collaboration with Sujaya Foundation, Maharashtra.


Totally 495 Children & Youth with Intellectual Disability, Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Visual Impairment and Hearing Impairment participated from Karnataka (Bangalore, Mysore, Hubli and Gadag), Tamil Nadu (Chennai, Kanchipuram, Ramanathapuram and Cuddalore) and Mumbai. We have followed necessary protocols during this pandemic situation.

Objective


- To conduct Quiz through digital based platforms in Karnataka Bangalore & other Districts, Mumbai & Tamilnadu Chennai & other Districts

- Setting up of Virtual classroom set up at SiA.
- Developing online quizzing format in collaboration with Quizmasters.
- To conduct Quiz for Children with Blind and Haring impairment through digital platform.


MOCK QUIZ TO COMPETITIVE GROUP (GROUP C & D)

PRELIMINARY ROUND – Virtual Quiz

The Prelims were organized for Children &Youth with Visual Impairment (Group C) and Children & Youth with Hearing Impairment (Group D) through zoom on 23rd Jan 2021. Totally 166 children participated from Karnataka (Bangalore, Mysore, Kalaburagi, Hubli and Gadag), Tamilnadu (Chennai, Kanchipuram and Ramanathapuram) and Mumbai. Six children & youth with disabilities from each category qualified for the finals.

After inauguration, the finals were organized for Children and youth with Visual & Hearing Impairment. Mr. Himadri Banerjee, Quiz master from 4 Edge Quizzing solutions conducted the Quiz in Mumbai, Mr. Surya Narayan, Quiz master, Catalyst Quiz Corp conducted the Quiz in Chennai and Mr. Anand Bhat, Quiz master, 4 Edge Quizzing Solutions conducted Quiz in Bangalore. Totally 36 children & youth with children VI & HI participated from three States, finally the winner and runner up were announced in each category from each State.

AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

- •As probably mentioned, the network was a big issue in Bengaluru. Due to that the flow of the quiz was highly affected and the final show was hampered due to it.
- •The language coordination is something that needs to be worked on from our side and the local translator.
- •Online Viewership could be increased.
- •A central coordinator for the entire event would be helpful
- •One of the guizzes was cut down due to time constraints, so something that we can do while scheduling the event is to ensure ample buffer time to account for delays associated with tech issues.
- In the prelims there were cases of people helping the students so this has to be looked at to ensure fairness for all participants.

ONLINE QUIZ THROUGH WEB PORTAL

The online Quiz was conducted on 23rd Jan 2021 for Children & Youth with Intellectual Disability, Autism and Cerebral Palsy through web portal. On that day the portal was made accessible from 10 am to 10 pm to login anytime to take the quiz and it was on the same day in all the three states. Each participant has been provided login id and password to open the quiz through portal. The questions were in multiple choice and in 4 languages – English, Kannada, Tamil and Hindi. The time allotted for each participant to complete the quiz is 40 min. After submitting the quiz, the E-Certificate can be taken as printout/save pdf by the participant. Totally 301 children participated the quiz in the portal. 27 children could not able to participate because of the personal reasons. The Volunteers' support made accessible to the needy participants.





For the first time, Quizabled went completely virtual. Initially, we did have doubts about how these children would answer if they would know to use their devices. etc. But, after a quick survey, we found that they were pretty aware of the functionalities of Zoom and we took off from there. As with every year, the questions were made a little difficult this year as well. We wanted to bring in a theme this year to help them think within borders. We decided to keep the theme as 2020 since we wanted to try and test if the students are following the news every day. Given that it was streaming online, it would have painted a bad picture had the questions went unanswered. But the kids didn't fail to surprise me. Questions were answered within few seconds and sometimes the kids were aware of things that even normal kids wouldn't be. One such answer was LeBron James which many of my friends aren't aware of.

The positive thing for quizmasters like me is that we don't have to set the questions thinking they are special children anymore. It's going to be of the same level as any regular quiz in the market, and like I said during the quiz, these kids can even win the regular quizzes if they get an opportunity to participate -**Mr. Surya Narayanan, Quiz master, Catalyst Quiz Corp**
